The abstract is not concised. It should have information on why and how the methodology was used. As it is now, I can not understand how you did it.

INTRODUCTION Do not use 'abundant sunshine', please use scientific terms such as 'hours of light' and give a concise number.

Up to line 5–>This information should be in the material and methods section, not here L8–>Please check the order of the names when typing them L23-29–>This paragraph does not show any relationship with the above paragraph. You were talking about fish-scale pits and suddenly change to the mulch application.

The aim and objectives of the work are not well defined and explained in the text.

MATERIALS AND METHODS \*Study site Please revise the English as it is very hard to follow your work L12->Why in a south-ward direction? What do you mean? L15->In agronomy you do not need to write that but 2X3 m

\*Soil water measurements L5-10->This is already known. I would delete the sentence Equation1->This is not the way of writing equation for scientific purposes L20-28->Please revise the English as it is very hard to follow your work

\*Indexes L4->How do you know that? Again, not the way of typing equations
