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Dear Dr. Strieder, thanks for your letter and comments provided.

I acknowledge the efforts done in revisiting the ms., but I am still convinced that is interest of the Journal as well as of the Authors to start over with this ms. and, eventually, prepare a new submission with another round of review. Too much work is in fact needed at this stage to reshape the ms.; actually almost complete rewriting.

In the new submission the Authors should first provide evidence for the Jurassic-Cretaceous age of deformation. This is a crucial point that should deserve particular attention in the revised ms. Presenting field examples of overprinting relationships among the fault systems would also help the reader to follow the fault inversion results

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and the consequent tectonic model. Finally, yes, your work is potentially interesting for a broad audience as you stated in the letter, but the reasons why this would be so should be clearly stated in the introduction.

Once again, sorry for the negative decision and thanks for having submitted your work to Solid Earth
