The methods used are valid however more work is needed to clearly outline it. — The methodology has been revised and some new works have been added to introduction.

The manuscript needs to be reviewed by an English native speaker — It has been revised by a person familiar with English grammar. Also if you think I can request a English native speaker to revised paper.
