The paper provides an update on activity in the Urals, and the southern Urals in particular, since the end of EUROPLOBE. As a contribution to the special issue on the scientific legacy of Prof. Andrés Pérez-Estaún I consider the manuscript content acceptable. If the paper were for a regular issue I would not. However, before proceeding with acceptance the following need to be addressed:

1. I am not a geologist, a thorough geological review of the content is necessary. Most claims seem reasonable, but they need to be verified by a knowledgeable geologist.
2. The English needs significant improvement. I have had a first try at it (see the

marked MS), but more can be done. After my corrections the MS should be edited again for English.

It was interesting to read the MS and I believe most people that were involved EUROPLOBE will think the same.
